Upon motion duly made and adopted, the following resolution was adopted by the EVP Committee en banc, thus:


RESOLUTION NO. 001-2001


RESOLVE, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that project proposals submitted by applicants for No Objection Statement in lieu of the 2-year home-country residency requirement must be implementable within two (2) years, and must include at least one (1) working visit in the Philippines for a reasonable period in connection with the project.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that project proposals submitted by applicants for No Objection Statement must be endorsed by the head or duly authorized representative of the selected partner institution for the project; and must be covered by a Memorandum of Agreement signed by the EVP participant, the head or duly authorized representative of the partner institution, and the authorized representative of the EVP Committee.






